⚠ CAUTION: Installer must provide adequate attachment hardware and anchors as required. Installer must also ensure that structure is of adequate strength.

- Read instructions through completely before proceeding.
- Follow instructions carefully. Installation contrary to instructions invalidates warranty.
- Screen should be accessible for complete removal should surface become damaged or should other service be required.
- Screen should be installed level (using a carpenter's level).
- 5. Nothing should be fastened to screen frame or viewing surface.
- 6. Ensure all parts are present.

- 7. Regardless of mounting method, screen should be positively and securely supported so that vibration or even abusive pulling on viewing surface will not cause case to loosen or fall. Installer must ensure that fasteners used are of adequate strength and suitable for mounting surface chosen.

- 8. Draper recommends using two people for assembly and installation. When lifting assembled screen, do not lift at only one corner; lift at both corners. Lifting by one corner could result in damage to the screen frame, especially on large screens.
- **9.** The ideal temperature range for assembling permanently tensioned screens to prevent damaging the surface is 68°-78° F (20°-26° C). Assembling below recommended temperatures may damage surface and void warranty.
- **10.** Use extreme care when handling TecVision surfaces. To prevent damaging the TecVision viewing surface, Draper strongly reccommends using white gloves.


- All brackets and other hardware must be installed level. Unit must be level and square.


Section 1 - Assembling Screen Subframe


Please Note: Installer must provide adequate attachment hardware and anchors as required. Installer must also ensure that structure is of adequate strength.


Please Note: Installer may need to modify subframe to accommodate lighting features. Ensure that such modifications do not compromise structural integrity of the subframe or screen assembly.



- Create a staging area for assembling screen:
- A. Place the carboard roller containing Screen Surface and the wrapped Bezel Trim Pieces (if applicable) aside.
- **B.** Spread blanket, drop cloth, or other soft protective surface over a large table or floor space.
- C. Unwrap and lay out in the general order of assembly:
 - Subframe sections
 - Corner Brackets & Screws
 - Mounting Brackets
 - Mounting Screws












Section 2 - Hanging Brackets and Testing Screen Placement

Please Note: This process is best accomplished with at least 2 (two) installers.

Test Screen Subframe placement before attaching screen surface to frame. Install Mounting Brackets to mounting surface or fly cables, approximately 16"-24" in from edge. Larger screens will require additional bracket installed at center mounting point.


Please Note: Installer must provide adequate attachment hardware and anchors as required. Installer must also ensure that mounting structure is of adequate strength.

Caution: DO NOT use the fly bracket set screws as mounting hardware!



Hang subframe on the wall or from fly cables.

For Wall Mounted Screens:




For Flown Screens:


Insert the assembled subframe into the Fly Mounting Brackets and tighten set screws.

Please Note: Adjust set screws to level subframe.

Caution: DO NOT
use the fly bracket
set screws
as mounting
hardware!



Ensure subframe is level and lays flat when installed on mounting brackets.








Section 3 - Preparing for Screen Surface Attachment, Optional Lighting

Please Note: This process is best accomplished with at least 2 (two) installers.

Remove subframe from mounting brackets and lay it on top of blanket, drop cloth, or other soft protective surface in staging area, front side facing up, hook & loop side facing down.





Optional LED backlighting (by others) can be installed into the ½" (13mm) channel on the back of the frame. If lighting strips are being installed, apply them to back of screen subframe now.

Please Note: Installer may need to modify subframe to accommodate lighting features. Ensure that such modifications do not compromise structural integrity of the subframe or screen assembly.




LED light by others.

Remove Screen Surface Fabric from cardboard tube and carefully slide end from inner cardboard tube. Set aside foam padding sheets for later use.

Please Note: Use included soft gloves whenever handling screen surface.


Spread on top of subframe. Align each corner of subframe with the cut corners of the screen surface.





Section 4 - Attaching Screen Surface to Screen Subframe

Please Note: This process is best accomplished with at least 2 (two) installers.




At first corner, pull the edge of the screen surface fabric and wrap it snugly around the subframe, joining the hook and loop strips.

Please Note: Use soft white gloves whenever handling front of screen surface.




Attach the screen surface to the opposite diagonal corner of the subframe, and repeat on the other corners, as shown below.

Caution: Take care not to deform or tear screen surface.









Section 5 - Adjusting Screen Surface

Review screen surface for ripples and flatness of screen surface. GENTLY undo each hook and loop strip and CAREFULLY pull screen surface as necessary to make small adjustments. Repeat as necessary.


PLEASE NOTE: Adjust horizontal (long) sides FIRST, then adjust vertical (short) sides. Repeat as necessary.

Caution: Take care not to deform or tear screen surface.i

Please Note: Some wrinkles will resolve when screen is vertical for a few minutes as fabric settles, acclimates, and relaxes.




Section 6 - Applying Adhesive Tabs (for Borderless screen option ONLY)




Section 7 - Attaching Bezel Trim to Screen Subframe (Optional) (33/16" version shown)

- Spread out the foam padding sheets from the screen surface tube and lay subframe and screen on top, with surface facing *DOWN*. Arrange top and side Bezel pieces in general order of assembly.
- Slide Bezel Trim pieces onto subframe, aligning holes with holes in the corner brackets, in the following order:
 - A. Bottom piece FIRST.
 - **B.** Side piece SECOND.
 - C. Side piece THIRD.
 - D. Top Piece LAST.




Align bezel trim piece holes with holes in subframe corner brackets and *loosely* attach bezel trim pieces with provided screws and washers.



Once all bezel trim pieces are aligned and loosely attached, tighten the screws and washers as necessary to fasten bezel trim pieces to the screen and draw the mitered corners snugly together.

Please Note: Press mitered corners together while tightening for best results.





Stand screen upright, review for fit and finish, and hang screen as outlined in Section 2 on Page 4.


Some wrinkles will resolve when screen is vertical for a few minutes as fabric settles, acclimates, and relaxes.






